WHAT ARE WE LEARNING?

Unit 2: Extreme Weather (Open Court Reading)

Reading: Students will comprehend text by asking questions and clarifying. Students will compare and contrast, identify nonfiction text features, and classify and categorize.

Writing: Students will do prewriting, drafting, editing, and revising for informational pieces

Grammar: Students will learn about regular/Irregular Plural Nouns, Types of Sentences, Subjects/Direct Objects, and Pronouns.

Spelling: Students will spell words with long i, long o, long u and /oo/ sound. They will about Irregular Verbs, Abstract Nouns, Homophones, Homographs & Multiple-Meaning Words.
